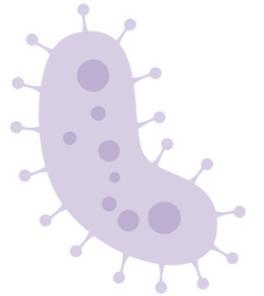


Pneumococcal vaccination

Pneumococcus is a bacterium found in the respiratory system, such as the nose and throat. Pneumococcal infections can be serious and sometimes fatal.



The vaccine is recommended and free for:

- People aged 65 and over
- People who are at higher risk of serious pneumococcal infection (e.g. people with a weakened immune system or a chronic illness)

Why get vaccinated?

- The vaccine provides protection against several types of pneumococci that are most prevalent in the winter and spring in Québec.
- Most people respond well after the vaccine.
- Getting vaccinated is the best way to protect yourself against pneumococcus.
